About Tonight's Game

Mount St. Mary's University, located in Emmitsburg, Maryland, has an enrollment of 2,100 students and the Mount are members of the Northeast Conference...Mount St. Mary's returns 12 letterwinners (and its six top scorers) from a squad that finished 14-16 in 2011-12...Rider returns nine letterwinners (and four starters) from a team that finished last season 11-19, 3-15 in the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference...the Broncs finished with the best non-conference record (8-3) out of the 10 MAAC teams...Rider is led by junior MyNeshia McKenzie, who was named a preseason Second Team All-MAAC honoree after finishing 2011-12 on the All-MAAC Third Team...McKenzie, who led the MAAC in rebounding last season, was a member of the MAAC All-Rookie team in 2010-11...the Broncs are also led by senior Caitlin Bopp, a preseason All-MAAC Third team selection after making the MAAC All-Rookie team in 2009-10 and current senior Sirona Chambers who had 18 points, six rebounds and six assists in Rider's season opening win (62-50) at Stony Brook on November 9...Rider won at Mount St. Mary's 53-44 on December 29, 2011 with Chambers scoring 15 points and pulling down six rebounds...Mount St. Mary's leads the all-time series 16-5 however Rider has won the last two in the series between the former NEC rivals which resumed the series last season for the first time since December 18, 2004.

Rider in Season Openers/ Home Openers/MAAC Openers

Rider is 5-14 in the last 19 season openers having defeated Stony Brook 62-50 to open the 2012-13 season...Rider is 9-14 in the last 23 home openers...the Broncs are 4-11 all-time in MAAC openers after losing at Manhattan on January 2, 2012.

Three for Six

Head coach Lynn Milligan, Associate Head Coach Pam Durkin and Assistant Coach John Miller all return for their sixth seasons.

Ffrench Canadian

Saint Joseph's grad and Canada native Whitney Ffrench joined the coaching staff in July, 2010. Ffrench played under Milligan at Saint Joseph's before assisting at Wagner College where she earned her master's degree.

Miller Time vs. the Mount

Rider assistant coach John Miller was an assistant coach at Mount St. Mary's in 2006-07 after serving as a team manager for four years. Miller graduated from Mount St. Mary's with a Business degree (Communication minor) and also earned his MBA in Emmitsburg, Maryland.

Head Coach Lynn Milligan

Rider Head Coach Lynn Milligan is in her sixth season as head coach. Milligan came to Rider from Saint Joseph's University where she was a six-year assistant coach. Three of her last five recruiting classes for the Hawks were nationally ranked and the Hawks had 111 wins in her six seasons including five WNIT appearances. Prior to coaching at Saint Joseph's, Milligan was the top assistant coach at Drexel University for six seasons. Milligan is a 1992 graduate of then Rider College with a degree in Communication and earned her master's in Counseling in 1994 from Rider. Milligan was a two-sport stand out as Lynn Donovan lettering in basketball and softball. As a senior in 1992, Milligan helped lead the Broncs to a 9-3 record in the East Coast Conference and as a graduate assistant at Rider, the Broncs compiled a 35-20 record including a 25-11 record in the Northeast Conference. Milligan is the 19th head coach in the 74-year history of the sport at Rider.

Streakers

Rider had its five-game winning streak broken at Manhattan on January 2, 2012...that was Rider's longest winning streak since the 1993-94 season when the Broncs won seven in a row...the Broncs also posted four-game winning streaks during the 1994-95, 1995-96 & 1996-97, 1999-2000 and 2008-09 seasons.

Three for All

The Broncs had made a three-point field goal in 104 straight games before the streak was ended at Princeton on December 5, 2010...the Broncs had made a three-pointer in 89 straight home games before going 0-3 against Fairfield on February 26, 2012.

Rider held Mount St. Mary's to 44 points on December 29, 2011, the 12th time (and fourth time last season) under head coach Lynn Milligan that Rider has held an opponent under 50 points...the Broncs held Stony Brook to 41 points on December 6, 2011...Rider held St. Francis (NY) to 22 points in the first half on November 30, 2011 and 48 points in the game and the Broncs held Bucknell to one field goal and seven points in the second half on November 13, 2011 in a 63-43 win...in 2009-10, Rider allowed only 41 points against Monmouth (November 19, 2009) and held the Hawks to 13 points in the second half. The Broncs also held Siena to 45 points in the 2010 MAAC tournament.

Rider Alumni

Former Broncs you may have heard of:

Jack Armstrong. An All-American pitcher for Rider in 1985 as a sophomore, went on to start the 1990 Major League All-Star game as a rookie pitcher for the World Champion Cincinnati Reds.

Clair Bee. An accounting professor, founded Rider varsity sports in 1928-29 and coached football, basketball and baseball. Compiled a 53-7 three-year record in basketball before moving on to LIU, where he won National Championships. A member of the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame, Bee wrote the popular Chip Hilton books and invented the shot clock and the three-second rule.

Christine Catalanotto '05. Two-year letterwinner at Rider, graduating Magna cum Laude with a degree in Psychology. Served two seasons as a graduate assistant coach at Wagner College and is now in her fifth season as an assistant coach at Manhattan College.

Pam Durkin '97. Current women's basketball associate head coach at Rider.

Harry Gamble '52. Member of the last football team at Rider (1951) and went on to be President of the Philadelphia Eagles...member of the Rider Athletics Hall of Fame.

Dick Kuchen '66. Graduated from Rider as the career leader in rebounds and was fifth in career scoring, made the winning fouls shots as Rider upset NYU. Was the head coach at Cal-Berkley and Yale.

Jack Madden '65. Graduated from Rider as the career leader in points and rebounds in basketball and was 20-5 as a Bronc pitcher on the baseball team. Went on to enjoy a long career as an NBA referee, including 25 NBA championship series games.

Lauren Thomer '04. After two seasons as an assistant at Army, Thomer was named the head coach at Manhattanville College in Purchase, New York in October, 2009 and was awarded conference coach of the year honors in her first season.

Jason Thompson '08. Four-year letterwinner for men's basketball...drafted by the Sacramento Kings of the NBA in the first round (12th pick overall) in 2008. In his fourth season with the Kings.

Speaking of Alumni

1997 Rider grad and current Associate Head Coach of the Broncs Pam Durkin was inducted into the Al Carino Basketball Club South Jersey Hall of Fame on February 10, 2010. Durkin, now in her fifth season on the coaching staff at Rider, was the 1997 Rider Female Athlete of the Year and earned All-Northeast Conference honors as a senior, ranking seventh in the nation in rebounding at 11.7 boards per game. Then freshman Caitlin Bopp pulled down 16 boards against Manhattan on January 31, 2010, the most rebounds by a rookie since freshman Shaunice Parker had 17 rebounds on November 9, 2007 against Monmouth and Kara Borel had 16 rebounds against Canisius on February 11, 2005. Then rookie MyNeshia McKenzie pulled in 15 rebounds against Loyola Maryland on January 4, 2011, pulled down 14 against Iona on February 6, 2011 and had 12 boards against Saint Peter's on January 15, 2011 and 12 rebounds at Niagara on February 18, 2011.

The Best Things in Life are Free (Throws)

On February 19, 2010, led by a seven for seven performance from then freshman Caitlin Bopp, Rider went 19 for 19 (that's 1.000 percent for the Jeff Nolan's of the world who don't like math) from the free throw line against Saint Peter's...the last time Rider was perfect from the line was against Princeton on December 29, 2007 when the Broncs went four for four.

Game on the Line

In the 30 games last season, Rider made a living at the free throw line, recording 374 of 1,670 points (22.4 percent) from the charity stripe. After shooting 61 percent from the line in 2010-11, (costing the Broncs almost 10 points per game), Rider improved to a 67.3 percent success rate in 2011-12. Rider shot a season-high 16 for 17 (.941) from the line at Loyola Maryland on February 4, 2012.

The Kiss of Jeff

Junior Carleigh Brown was a perfect seven for seven from the free throw line for the 2011-12 season, including three for three against Princeton until Rider radio personality Jeff Nolan told our expansive listening audience that Carleigh hadn't missed yet in the game or this season. C. Brown went on to miss both free throws.

Welcome to the Show

For the fourth season in a row, a rookie began her Bronc career in the starting lineup with Taylor Wentzel making the starting five at Stony Brook on November 9, 2012. Last season, Emily Fazzini cracked the starting five against Lafayette on November 11, 2011. MyNeshia McKenzie made the start at Bucknell on November 12, 2010, opening the 2010-11 campaign. In 2009-10, Rider rookie Carleigh Brown made her first collegiate start in her first game on November 13, 2009 against Seton Hall. Carleigh was the first Rider rookie to start her first collegiate game since Stephanie Wisniewski started against Rice on November 12, 2006. Fazzini started all 30 games for Rider last season, the first rookie to accomplish that since Kara Borel who started all 28 games in 2003-04.

On February 15, 2012, 218 of Rider's 326 athletes were honored at halftime of the men's basketball game for compiling a 3.00 grade point average of higher for the Fall 2011 semester...from women's basketball, Carleigh Brown, Emily Fazzini, Sarah Homan, Kornelija Valiuskyte, Aisha Varnadore, Caitlin Bopp, Shereen Lightbourne and MyNeshia McKenzie were recognized. The Spring 2012 semester academic honorees will be recognized November 29, 2012 at the men's basketball game against La Salle.

From the desk of Athletic Trainer Gina Dain, junior Shereen Lightbourne will miss the 2012-13 season with a knee injury. Sophomore Emily Fazzini is expected to miss the first few games of the season with an ankle injury. Red-shirt freshman (second semester) Manon Pellet has continued her recovery from an ACL injury and is expected to see limited playing time.

Taking Care of Business and Working Lots of Overtime

Rider lost to Iona in the opening round of the MAAC tournament in overtime, 61-60 on March 1, 2012...the Broncs lost to Canisius 61-58 in overtime on February 10, 2012. Rider won at Niagara in triple overtime on February 18, 2011 79-73, defeated Iona 93-87 in double overtime on February 6, 2011 and the Broncs defeated Saint Peter's in overtime on January 15, 2011 by a 70-69 score...Rider did not play any overtime games in 2009-10.

Under head coach Lynn Milligan the Broncs are 6-4 in overtime games.

Rider was 1-1 in overtime in 2008-09 having lost at Monmouth 50-48 on November 24, 2008 after defeating Fairleigh Dickinson November 21, 2008 by a 65-64 score. The back to back overtime games were Rider's first since the 1989-90 season, when the Broncs lost to Penn before bouncing back to defeat LIU.

Rider went 2-1 in overtime games in 2007-08. The Broncs lost to Siena 84-81 on February 29, 2008 after defeating the Saints on January 27, 2008 by a score of 77-73. The Broncs also defeated Army on December 12, 2007 by a score of 66-61.

Before the Iona game on February 6, 2011, Rider's last double overtime contest was February 11, 1993 against Marist in a Northeast Conference game when the Broncs lost 78-75.

The Niagara game on February 18, 2011 is believed to be Rider's first triple overtime game.

Renovated Alumni Gymnasium

In the Fall of 2012, Alumni Gymnasium reopened to competition after a summer of renovations. On July 25, 2007, Rider Athletics unveiled a new Bronc logo. Only the fourth Rider Athletics logo in history, the original 'Roughrider' logo was designed by the legendary Clair Bee 80 years ago and was last used in 1989 when Rider switched to an upright Bronc. When Rider gained University status in 1994, a 'U' was incorporated into the logo. Due to a flood in August, 2009, the Alumni Gym floor was completely replaced with the gym reopening for competition in November, 2009.



Same Name, New Website

In January, 2008, the Rider Department of Athletics unveiled the redesigned GoBroncs.com website and the site, through a year-long process was updated again with a redesign that launched November 21, 2011. Through a partnership with Neulion, we are now able to offer more content (over 80,000 pages and counting), and 'BroncVision' which streams (audio and video) for the home men's basketball games, women's basketball games and wrestling matches (except for televised events). With the evolution of the site, other Rider sporting events were added in 2010-11 (men's and women's soccer and field hockey, along with volleyball). Enhanced LiveStats via 'GameTracker' is also offered for all Rider home events in men's and women's soccer, field hockey, volleyball, men's and women's basketball, baseball and softball.
